Opaque or translucent results — All styles may be specified for either opaque or translucent results.

Variable translucency — at standard, translucent components are fabricated to approximate 50% translucency (where approximately one half the light is transmitted). Alternately, you may specify translucency to be greater or lesser than 50 percent.

Please Note: when light is transmitted through translucent colorations, they become more ethereal — color is lightened. In artificial light environments, it is recommended that lighting intensity be adjustable, to accommodate changes in ambient conditions and to effect desired luminosity.

Standard colorways — UltraGlas has developed a number of standard colorways in design-forward color combinations for use with any application style. Please visit UltraGlas.com for updates.

Custom colors to coordinate precisely with your palette — UltraGlas components may be specified to incorporate any standard UltraGlas color — and custom formulated colors may be specified (custom color-matching fee applies to all custom formulated colors) — provide references.

Custom styles — should you envision a color application style that you don't see in our catalog (at UltraGlas.com), please provide reference materials. UltraGlas is always eager to provide the design professional with solutions that complement the most discerning specification.

Color relativity — guidelines may be provided to assist us in the creation of desired predominance (percentages) of chosen colors.

Selectivity of color application — specified areas or line art patterns (including lettering) may be left clear, or may assume an overall background color. Color may also be confined to specified area(s).

Sizes and shapes — up to 69-1/2" x 119-1/2" x 3/4" (in some cases larger, call for specifics).
